Air Conditioning Units Have Arrived

They are behind the worship center on the concrete slabs that were poured by some of our men week before last. You will recall that we had planned to purchase an A/C unit to replace the one that failed last year and that the cost of that unit was going to be a good deal at \$7,000. Just recently we learned of an ever better deal in replacing the unit. It was such a good deal that, after discussion with the Building and Grounds Committee and the Finance Committee, we decided that it would be wise to purchase two instead of just one. With the first unit having failed, everybody agreed that it is likely that the other unit wouldn't last that much longer either. We had learned that a good price for just one of the A/C units was going to be a little more than \$10,000. (As noted above, we had already secured a better deal than that in being able to purchase one for \$7,000.) The good news is that we have purchased two units for right around \$10,000 once you include taxes and the expense of going to pick them up. At this point in time, we have collected \$6,828 toward that roughly \$10,000 that is needed for the expenses toward securing the new air conditioning units. Of course, if you still desire to contribute toward this need, you can make out your check to "Pleasant View Baptist Church," place it in an envelope, and mark on it "for A/C unit." We grateful for the ingenuity and work of our men; without their availability, the cost of this project would have been over \$25,000.
