3. **Martha Poore** (mother of Donna Hammond and Amanda Vancil) She feels miserable and is doing very poorly. She was admitted to AAMC room 575 Thursday, April 16, but with this coronavirus going on, of course, she cannot have visitors. She has had 2 rounds of antibiotics. She is having very bad problem with drainage on her leg which is extremely large due to the fluid on it. Her heart rate and blood pressure are both bad. Martha and her family are much in need of our prayers.
4. **Sarah Williams** - Her cancer in her liver has grown to the size of an egg and she is to begin radiation treatments Tuesday, April 21. The pain from the cancer makes it hard for her to breathe and to sleep.
5. **Jerry Williams** - He is much improved from the injuries resulting from his fall. He is likely to be dismissed from Home Health Care this coming Monday, April 20.
6. **Herman Fant** (brother of Ruby Miller who had lung cancer) He went to the emergency room Saturday, April 4, as he thought he'd had a stroke. He was unable to speak clearly. It turned out that it was not a stroke but a reaction to eye medication. He is back home now.
