### "Love not the World" I John 2:15-17 NIV

I. Let's look at three phrases which describe what we are doing when we are guilty of loving the world, that is, when we are practicing worldliness.

- A. The "\_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_" refers to anything that appeals to man's out-of-control desire.
- B. The "\_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_" refers to pleasures that satisfy the eyes and the mind.
- C. The "\_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_" refers to trying to impress others with our importance.
