A called Business meeting...

... will be held on January 26th to select the individuals to serve on the Pastor Search Committee as defined in Section Two of the Church Constitution:

SECTION 2 The election shall be upon the recommendation of a special committee elected to seek out and nominate as pastor a minister of the Gospel whom such committee feels led of the Holy Spirit to present. Election shall be by secret ballot. Each member present and voting shall submit five (5) names. The votes shall be tabulated by persons appointed by the moderator for that purpose. The five (5) receiving the highest number of votes shall be duly elected. In the event of a tie vote, the number shall be increased to six (6). In the event anyone cannot serve, the person receiving the next highest number of votes shall be elected to serve.
